## 1. INTRODUCTION

### 1.1. Rally of Nations Guanajuato 200 AÑOS 2024

This rally will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code including appendices, the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations including appendices, the FEMADAC Sporting Code (only when related to Mexican Rally Championship cars), the National Rally Commission of Mexico Sporting Regulations (only when related to Mexican Rally Championship cars), the WADA/NADA Codes and the FIA Antidoping Regulations. The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated Bulletins (issued by the Clerk of the Course or the Stewards).

### 1.2. Road Surface

- The Rally stages will be run on gravel.
- The Street Stage GTO (SS 1/2) will be run on cobblestone and concrete [1.10 $\mathrm{km}]$.
- The Street Stage León (SS 15) will be run on asphalt [1.09 km].


### 1.3. Distances

This Rally will have a total Itinerary distance of 747.18 kilometers, of which 188.41 kilometres will be Special Stages (25\%). The Rally will be divided into 7 sections.

4. ENTRIES
4.1. Closing Date for Entries

NACAM: Friday, February 9th 2024 at 18:00 hrs. (GMT - 6 hrs).
CNRM: Thursday, February $15^{\text {th }}, 2024$ at 18:00 hrs. (GMT - 6 hrs).
Rally of Nations: Thursday, February $15^{\text {th }}, 2024$ at 18:00 hrs. (GMT - 6 hrs).

### 4.2. Entry Procedure

### 4.2.1 Rally of Nations

The "Rally of Nations" is a competition for teams representing their countries.
Crews already entered into the FIA NACAM Rally of Nations Guanajuato 2024 as NACAM or CNRM competitors will be automatically entered in the Rally of Nations competition and have their Rally of Nations entry fee waived.

Other crews wishing to enter must fill out the Rally of Nations Entry Form, available from http://www.rallymexico.com/ and submit it to entries@rallymexico.com , along with proof of payment of the Rally of Nationsonly entry fee. Foreign drivers must submit an approval letter from their ASN in the same e-mail.

Teams: Crews participating in the Rally of Nations competition must do so in teams of two cars, the drivers of which should preferably be of the same nationality. Entrants must indicate the identity of their teammate on the Rally of Nations Entry Form. Teams where both drivers are of the same nationality will be taken as representatives of their country and assigned a team name which includes it. Teams where drivers are of different nationalities will not include a country in their name. The organizer will assign a team to any entrant left without a teammate by the Rally of Nations entry closing date.

Eligibility: Both drivers of the team entered must hold current FIA competition licenses issued by the Nation they represent. The codrivers can be of different nationalities. For eligible cars see 4.5.

Number of teams: The maximum number of teams will be twenty-three teams of at most two cars. A country may be represented by more than one team, for example (a), (b), (c) teams. However, the teams shall remain as in the entry form for the duration of the Rally. In case there is an odd number of cars entered, or there are countries with only one driver entered, the Clerk of the Course may allow one-car teams.

Team Representative: Each team must nominate a team representative (Team Manager) who may be a crew member in a team car or a non competing nominee. The team representative will be responsible for all pre-event arrangements between the team and the organizers and for representing the team in all matters during the running of the event.

### 4.2.2 NACAM

Crews registered for the 2024 NACAM Rally Championship are automatically preentered into the FIA NACAM Rally of Nations Guanajuato 2024 as NACAM competitors, and need only confirm their intention directly with the championship manager (corderoca@yahoo.com), and pay the corresponding entry fee. The NACAM entry form can be obtained directly from the NACAM Rally Championship manager (corderoca@yahoo.com).

### 4.2.3 CNRM

Crews wishing to participate in FIA NACAM Rally of Nations Guanajuato 2024 as CNRM competitors and be classified for the Mexican Rally Championship must register using the electronic entry form available at http://cnrm.com.mx/ duly completed before the closing date for entries. The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry Fee. To be accepted, competitors must send proof of payment by e-mail to the secretary of the event (entries@rallymexico.com) by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN in the same e-mail.

To be entered into both NACAM and CNRM classifications, crews must submit both the NACAM entry form, the online CNRM entry form and pay both entry fees.

### 4.3. Documents to be submitted

All entry applications should be accompanied by:

- Proof of payment of the total entry fee
- The following scanned documents:
- FIA License of the entrant and both members of the crew (NACAM and foreign crews only)
- FEMADAC License of both members of the crew (CNRM and Mexican crews only)
- Driver's License of the crew members
- First page of the homologation papers of the car with the number, group and cylinder capacity
- Approval letter from their ASN (foreign crews only)

In the case the Driver and Entrant are the same person, both licences (Driver \& Entrant) must be submitted with the entry form and presented at the administrative check-in.

### 4.4. Number of Entrants Accepted

The maximum number of entries is 45 . If more than 45 entries are received, the Organisers will create a reserve list.

Entry applications outside the FIA Championships (NACAM) will be confirmed after the entry closing date.

The criteria for acceptance of entries will be in the following order:
NACAM, then Rally of Nations, then CNRM.
The Organisers reserve the right to accept all other entries according to the driver results and the capacity / conditions of the vehicle entered.
4.5. Accepted Cars \& Classes

NACAM: Cars are eligible to enter as stipulated in Article 12.1 of the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations. All vehicles must comply with the provisions of Appendix J Article 253 to the International Sporting Code 2024.

## 5. INSURANCE

Competitors and crews (driver and co-driver) are covered for public liability under a master policy held by the National Rally Commission of Mexico (CNRM) for $\$ 3,000,000.00$ MXN revolving coverage for any one accident or instance, up to a maximum total of $\$ 6,000,000.00 \mathrm{MXN}$. The coverage includes special stages as well as road sections. The coverage will come into effect at the start of the rally and will include the Shakedown. It will cease at the end of the event or at the moment of retirement or exclusion. Full details can be obtained upon request from the Organisers.

Service vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing official plates issued by the Organisers, may never be considered as official participants of the rally. Therefore, they are not covered under the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

Comprehensive vehicle insurance and personal accident insurance are the sole responsibility of the entrant / competitor. As per article 2.5 of the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, international crews are required to "have taken out an international insurance policy covering their repatriation, if necessary, after an accident".

Cars used for reconnaissance must be insured. Random checks may be carried out at any moment during reconnaissance, and proof of insurance must be produced by the crew at that time. Liability and third-party insurance as a minimum are compulsory for all crews under Mexican law.

## 6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

## Organizer's Advertising

Rally Plates and Optional Advertising must be affixed on the car before scrutineering as shown in Appendix 4 of these regulations.

## Restrictions

The advertising of alcoholic beverages is limited according to the Mexican legislation to alcoholic beverages under $22 \%$ in volume. Such brand logos may appear on the competition and service vehicles, as well as on drivers' overalls during the event.

## Identification Numbers

The Organisers will issue Competition Numbers, assigned by NACAM and CNRM. These Competition Numbers must be affixed on the car before pre-event scrutineering as shown in Appendix 4 of these regulations and must be visible throughout the duration of the rally.

## 7. TYRES

### 7.1. Tyres specified for use during the Rally

The make, model and compound of tyres are free for all competitors, so long as they comply with Arts. 13 to 15 and App. V of the 2024 FIA RRSR.

### 7.2. Quantity of Tyres

The maximum allowed number of tyres (including spares) for the whole rally and the Shakedown is 14.

8. FUEL
8.1. Fuel Distribution

Refuel Zones are as detailed in the Rally Itinerary. All Refuel Zones will be located at commercial filling stations, where all competitors must use the available commercial fuel. If a competing car cannot run on regular pump fuel, and must use special competition fuel, this fuel must be delivered to the designated fuel depot area within rally campus on Thursday, February $22^{\text {nd }}, 2024$, in standard steel fuel drums labelled with their car's competition number, from where it will be transported by the organizers to the Refuel Zones on the days of the competition.

The organizer can supply racing fuel to crews that request it. Please email compinfo@rallymexico.com for inquiries.

All cars must be refuelled at the designated refuelling zones in full compliance with Art. 61.2 of the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations and all fuel used must comply with ISC Appendix J Art. 252.

For environmental and safety reasons, no refuelling is allowed in the Service Park (no refuel from cans, drums or similar) except if authorised by Art. 58 of the 2024 FIA RRSR.

### 8.2. Refueling

All cars must comply with article 61.3 .3 of the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations.

## 9. RECONNAISSANCE

### 9.1. Registration Procedure

All NACAM and Rally of Nations entrants wishing to take part in reconnaissance must register at the Start Control of the first stage listed in the Reconnaissance Schedule on Thursday, February 22 ${ }^{\text {nd }}, 2024$, according to Appendix 2.

### 9.2. Schedule and number of passages

Reconnaissance for CNRM crews will be free up to Wednesday, February $21^{\text {st }}$, 2024. After that, they will have to follow the same schedule and be subject to the same limitations on number of passages as NACAM and Rally of Nations crews.

Each NACAM and Rally of Nations crew is limited to two passages on each special stage. During reconnaissance there shall be control marshals at the start and stop points of each group of stages as indicated in the reconnaissance schedule, to record the number of passages. Crews will only be permitted to enter and leave special stages through the start and finish controls. Further checks may also be carried out within special stages. This applies to NACAM, Rally of Nations and CNRM crews.

See Appendix 2 for the reconnaissance timetable. Note that SS 1 / 2, SS 5 / 8 / $11 / 14$ and Shakedown can only be reconnoitered at the time specified in Appendix 2, on Thursday, February 22nd 2024, and not during CNRM free reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance road books will not be issued. However, KMZ files with the suggested reconnaissance route will be published on the official website, which can be imported into various smartphone applications and GPS devices for navigation during recce.

### 9.3. Specific Restrictions

All reconnaissance cars must comply with Arts. 35.1 and 35.2 of the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations.

Some crews may be required by the Organizers to use a special system for controlling the speed throughout reconnaissance by means of a GPS.

On special stages, the speed limit is $70 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$ unless traffic signs or lower limit zones are indicated. Inside towns and populated areas, the speed limit is $40 \mathrm{~km} / \mathrm{h}$. Additional lower limit zones may be issued before the start of reconnaissance. Competitors are reminded that stages will be open to normal traffic during
reconnaissance and that they must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Speed will be measured at random points along the route, and any infraction detected will be reported to the stewards.
The maximum number of passengers on each special stage for reconnaissance is limited to two per entered crew.

All stages driven more than once in the rally will be considered as one stage for reconnaissance purposes.

Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in the special stages according to the schedule, or in the direction of the rally outside of the scheduled times, unless directed by the Organizers or authorities. Entering and leaving the special stage elsewhere than through Start and Finish controls is prohibited.

Failure to comply with any of these restrictions will result in a fine of \$2,500.00 MXN, which must be paid in full before the start of the Rally. Failing to do so will result in the crew not being allowed to start the Rally.

## 10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Administrative checks will take place at the rally secretariat following the specified schedule (Art. 3 of these regulations). All competitors must pass administrative checks before proceeding to pre-event scrutineering.

The Secretariat will be located inside Glowpoint Hotel (Mulza Outlet del Calzado) throughout the Rally.

### 10.1. Documents to be Presented

The following documents will be checked:

- FIA license of the entrant and both members of the crew (NACAM and foreign crews only)
- FEMADAC license of both members of the crew (CNRM and Mexican crews only)
- Valid Driver's Licence for both members of the crew
- Driver and Co-Driver passport or Identification
- ASN Stamp or letter of authorisation (for foreign competitors)
- Information given in the entry form
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car insurance registration papers

## 11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

Before pre-event scrutineering, competition numbers, rally plates and optional advertising, if accepted, must be affixed on the car.

### 11.1. Scrutineering Venue and Timetable

Pre-event Scrutineering will be performed from 08:00 to 20:00 on Thursday, February $22^{\text {nd }} 2024$, in the Scrutineering Area in Rally Campus at Mulza Outlet del Calzado, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Competitors are strongly encouraged to attend scrutineering at the earliest possible opportunity.

### 11.2. Transverse Mud Flaps

The use of Transverse Mud Flaps is mandatory as per Art. 252.7.7 of Appendix J of the FIA International Sporting Code - Mud flaps.

### 11.3. Windows / Nets

The use of tinted or silvered windows, according to Appendix J, Art 253 Art 11, is authorized on rear side windows only. Competitors are reminded that these silvered or tinted films must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle 70 mm in diameter, so that the crew and contents of the car may be seen from the outside of the car.

### 11.4. Driver's Safety Equipment

Although drivers are not required to be present, all items of clothing and equipment in compliance with FIA ISC Appendix L Chapter III -including helmets and FHR (Frontal Head Restraints) intended to be used- must be presented during scrutineering.
"Rally of Nations" crews not simultaneously entered as NACAM or CNRM competitors will be allowed to use safety equipment compliant with American Rally Association 2024 Rally Technical Rules Article 1 or Canadian Association of Rallysport Rule Book Articles 11.1.6 to 11.1.8, at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineering Officer. In addition to this equipment, they will be required to use (and present for scrutineering) fire-resistant gloves and footwear.

## 12. OTHER PROCEDURES

### 12.1. Ceremonial Start Procedure and Order

The start of the rally (TC0) will take place at the Parc Fermé OUT control in Forum Cultural Guanajuato on Thursday February $22^{\text {nd }}, 2023$ starting at 17:30 hrs. There will be no holding area prior to the start of the rally. Competitors must check in at TC 0 at their published start times.

From TC0 competitors will proceed to Silao, where a pre-start ceremony will take place between TC OA and TC 0B. From there they will proceed to TC 0C. Police will escort competitor cars from OB to 0C, in groups of ten cars; please wait for your escort. Sufficient time has been allocated for this in the itinerary.

The ceremonial start will take place between the TIME CONTROL and START CONTROL of SS1, at the "Alhóndiga de Granaditas" in Guanajuato. The start interval will be 2 minutes for all competitors in section 1. As specified in FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Art. 41.3, FIA priority drivers will start Section 1 at the front of the field, followed by all other competitors. The starting order within these two groups will be at the discretion of the organizers in the interest of spectators and television.

Since SS1 and SS2 use the same roads, and in the interest of spectator safety, there will be 20 minute gaps at TC0 and throughout Section 1 between the tenth and eleventh cars, the twentieth and twenty-first cars and so on, so that cars of similar speed will go through SS2 as a group. The result will be that the first 10car group will complete both passes through Street Stage GTO (SS1 \& SS2) before the second 10-car group starts its first pass (SS1). After the second group makes both its passes (SS1 \& SS2), then the third group starts SS1, and so on.

The start order will be as indicated in FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Art. 41.4 for the rest of the rally.

A waiting area will be established between SS 1 and SS 2, along Benito Juárez street in Guanajuato, starting at the corner of 5 de Mayo. Officials will direct competitors to park their cars here in the order in which they arrive, while waiting for their TC 2 check-in time. Competitors are kindly reminded to keep their personal belongings, including race helmets, gloves, etc., with them at all times; Although this area will be closed to vehicular traffic and have a strong police presence, it will be crowded and caution should be exercised.

### 12.2. Exhibition driving in the Ceremonial Start

Exhibition driving of any sort, including but not limited to "donuts", inside the control area at the start of SSS 1 and 2, is strictly forbidden and will be reported to the stewards.

### 12.3. Time Card Changes during the Rally

Time Cards will be issued or changed at the following time controls for the start of each section:

TC 0, TC 2B, TC 5C, TC 8C, TC 8F, TC 11C, TC 14C

### 12.4. Finish Procedure

The rally will end at Time Control TC 15A (Finish Area In).
After this control a pre-finish holding area will be established and crews will be directed to the podium at the appropriate times.

The full Finish Podium procedure will be published in a bulletin by the CoC.

### 12.5. Permitted Early Check-In

Competitors are allowed to check in early without incurring a penalty at:

- "Tech Zone IN - Overnight Regroup IN" control TC 2A
- "Regroup OUT - Flexi Service C IN" control TC 8C
- "Flexi Service C OUT" control TC 8D
- "Overnight Regroup IN" control TC 8E


### 12.6. Flexi-Service C

Since the Service Park and Overnight Regroup are in different locations, the procedure for Flexi-Service will deviate from the usual. There will be a regroup before Service C, but its Regroup OUT / Service IN control (TC 8C) and the Service OUT control (TC 8D) will both allow early check-in. This means that competitors will be able to pick a starting time for their service interval by checking-in early at TC 8C, and the length of their service by checking in early at TC 8D.

### 12.7. Official Time used during the Rally

## Start Intervals

Competitors will start Section 1 with a separation of 2 minutes between cars. The minimum start intervals between all cars from the start of Section 2, and for the remainder of the rally, will be 3 minutes.

Time
The official time throughout the rally will be that of the GPS satellite constellation.
12.8. Re-start after retirement

Restart after retirement is permitted as stipulated under Art. 54 of the 2024 FIA RRSR.

### 12.9. Shakedown

All crews will be required to complete two passages of the Shakedown, in an order and at an interval determined by the Organizer, in the interest of TV coverage. A start list for the Shakedown will be published at 11:00 on Friday, February $23{ }^{\text {rd }}$ 2024. At the conclusion of these fixed passages, the Shakedown stage will be opened for any crews who wish to keep using it.
12.10. "Rally of Nations" Final Classification

All teams entered in the Rally of Nations competition will appear in a separate Rally of Nations Classification. For "Rally of Nations" competing teams, the Rally will end at TC 15A.

### 12.11. NACAM-CNRM Classification

As per Article 12.3.4 of the FIA Regional Rally Championship Regulations, FIAapproved cars with ASN homologations will be permitted to enter the NACAM Rally Championship competition. These cars must, however, comply with the safety requirements as in Appendix J, Art. 253 of the ISC.

For CNRM competitors not simultaneously entered into NACAM, the Rally will end at TC 11B "Tech Zone OUT - Regroup IN", after which the CMR final provisional classification will be determined. They will be considered to have retired at TC 11B for the purposes of the "Rally of Nations" classification, and their cars will thereafter be kept in Parc Fermé until the Stewards authorize their

removal. CNRM competitors also entered as NACAM competitors will continue in the Rally until TC 15A and appear in the respective NACAM classification.

For the purposes of Rally of Nations and NACAM classifications, SS 13 Derramadero - El Brinco 2 will be considered as Power Stage.

For the purposes of CNRM classification, SS 10 Derramadero - El Brinco 1 will be considered as the Power Stage.

In case of any dispute between the regulations applicable for the NACAM Championships and the CNRM Sporting Regulations, the former shall take precedence, apart from the eligibility of cars.

### 12.12. Promotional Activities

The following is a provisional list of promotional activities. The Clerk of the Course will update this list, give additional details, and may designate participation in certain activities to be compulsory for some or all crews, by means of a bulletin. Please contact the Chief Media Officer for details.

## 14. RESULTS \& PRIZES

## 14.1. "Rally of Nations" Winner

### 14.1.1 Stage Classification for the Rally of Nations

Solely for the purpose of determining the classification for individual Special Stages for the "Rally of Nations" competition, a performance levelling calculation will be applied to stage times. The calculation will consist of multiplying the stage times (including penalties) of every crew entered in the Rally of Nations by a Performance Balancing Factor (PBF) specific to each crew, according to the car entered. The new times thus obtained will be used to determine the Rally of Nations Balanced Times for that stage.

The following table shows preliminary PBFs for typical models in the most common groups of cars, obtained through statistical analysis of stage times, and analysis of technical rules in various national and international championships. This table is merely illustrative, not exhaustive nor definitive, and has no regulatory value:

Performance Balancing Factors will be adjusted after pre-event scrutineering, and each car will be assigned its own PBF by the Clerk of the Course in consultation with the Chief Scrutineering Officer. The full list of PBFs assigned will be published in a bulletin before the start of the Rally.

### 14.1.2 Team Scoring

Results for the "Rally of Nations" Classification will be established as follows:
Points will be awarded to each member of a Team per each Special Stage or Super Special Stage completed.

Each crew will be awarded points according to its overall position in the stage classification (on the basis of Rally of Nations Balanced Times as described in 14.1.1) from the eligible crews (i.e. entered into the Rally of Nations) in each Super Special Stage or Special Stage. The best-classified crew of each Team will be awarded points as Car 1, the second crew as Car 2, according to the following scale:

The Power Stage will award double the normal points.
All the points earned will be added, and the Team with the most points at the end of the Rally will be declared the Winner of the Rally of Nations.

### 14.1.3 Penalties

For Special Stages or Super Special Stages: Only a False Start will incur point penalties. Penalties will be based on FIA RRSR Article 48.6, substituting 0.5 points for each second of penalty.

For each day: All penalties of the Regional Rally Sporting Regulations apply at a rate of 0.5 points per second of penalty.

### 14.1.4 Ties

Per Special Stage or Super Special Stage: If two or more cars have equal times on a given Special Stage or Super Special Stage, both cars will get the same corresponding points.

Per Day or Total: For drawing up the final classification of a Day or the final point tally of the Rally, if 2 cars have scored exactly the same total, the following will apply:
14.1.4.1 According to the greater number of first places, then second places, then third places, etc., achieved in the general classifications of the Special Stages or Super Special Stages by the fastest car of the team (as described in Art. 14.1.1) which have served to make up their points total.
14.1.4.2 According to the greater number of highest places achieved in the classifications of all the Special Stages or Super Special Stages in which each of the drivers with the same points score has taken part, one 7th place being worth more than any number of 8th places, one 8th place being worth more than any number of 9 th places, and so on.
14.1.4.3 In the event of a further tie, the rule for deciding between the teams concerned shall be according to the fastest time of the fastest car in each team for the first special stage, then the second special stage, etc.
14.1.4.4 In the event of a further tie, the Stewards will decide the winner and decide between any other tying drivers, on the basis of whatever other considerations they deem appropriate.

### 14.2. Best "Scudería"

An additional trophy will be awarded to the best rally car preparation shop, called a 'Scuderia'. Classification for this prize will be determined at the end of the rally by averaging the Rally of Nations scores of every car entered by each 'Scuderia'. The 'Scuderia' with the highest average score will be the winner.

### 14.3. Winners (NACAM and CNRM)

Results for NACAM Classification will be established as described in the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Art. 64.

Results for CNRM Classification will be established as described in the 2024 Sporting Regulations of the National Rally Commission of Mexico Art. 11.

- CMR Classification: $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$
- CMR Highest Placed Rookie: $1^{\text {st }}$
- Class Classification as per CNRM Art. 31.1: $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$

## 15. FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

### 15.1. Final Checks

Post event scrutineering will be held on Sunday February $25^{\text {th }}$ starting at 19:00 hrs in the Scrutineering Area in Fórum Cultural Guanajuato.

Those crews selected by the Stewards for final scrutineering will be notified by the clerk of the course and are required to provide the proper equipment and technicians in the Scrutineering Area in Fórum Cultural Guanajuato.

### 15.2. Protest Fees

As per Art. 65.2.1 of the FIA RRSR, the amount of the NACAM protest fee is $€ 1,000$. For CNRM protests, Art. 14.1 of the CNRM Regulations sets the fee at \$6,000 MXN.

If the protest requires the dismantling and the re-assembling of different parts of a car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit as per Art. 65.3.1 of the FIA RRSR.

The expenses incurred by the work and transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if the claim is upheld.

If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc) are higher than the deposit amount, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned to them.

### 15.3. Appeal Deposit

- Sum of the international appeal deposit: $€ 3,000$.
- Sum of the national appeal deposit: \$ 10,000 MXN.

## APPENDIX 5 - SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All the entrants and drivers are reminded of the Appendix L to the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, in particular regarding Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment (helmets, flame-resistant clothing, frontal head restraint (FHR) and safety belts).

Clothing comprising overalls, gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, balaclavas, socks and shoes must be homologated to FIA 8856-2000 or FIA 8856-2018 standards.

For Rally of Nations-only competitors (not simultaneously entered as NACAM or CNRM competitors), standards allowed under 2024 ARA Rally Technical Rules Article 1.3 and CARS Rule Book 2024 Article 11.1.8 will also be permitted, at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineering Officer.

These regulations also apply to the Shakedown stage.
